



## Participant Terms and Conditions

### Introduction

These Terms and Conditions govern your participation in the Fundamentally Dance Development activities (referred to herein as "the courses"). By registering for one of the courses, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

### Fundamentally Dance reserves the right to:

- make amendments and cancellations to schedules without prior notice, either before or during a session.
- merge published age groups and schedule classes as required.
- refuse any enrollment as permitted by law, or to request a participant leave a session if they are disruptive, late or have unpaid fees.
- refuse an enrolment if an applicant does not fulfil the age requirements for the class/session.
- retain all or part of the course fees in the event of the applicant's withdrawal

### **Please note:**

- deposits are non-refundable.
- all candidates must bring normal practice wear and female-identifying candidates are expected to bring pointe shoes with them
- the organisers will not be held responsible for any damage or injury, however caused, to any person attending the course, nor for the loss of any property
- leaders reserve the right to change the teachers or artists in the event of illness or any other unavoidable causes

## **Participants, Parents/Carers:**

- acknowledge that activities may be physical and hence involve the risk of accidental injury which Fundamentally Dance for accepts no liability for
- must advise Fundamentally Dance in advance if they/their child/the individual in their care has health problems and/or requires medication while attending an activity. Staff and workers take all due care of applicants during classes; however, cannot be responsible for the administration of medication or ensuring suitable health precautions are in place to suit all participants.

Approximately one week prior to each activity commencing, enrolled applicants will receive a confirmation communication providing details of registration, venue, faculty and schedule. Please note that these are subject to change at short notice although every effort will be taken to ensure otherwise. If no communication from Fundamentally Dance has been received one week prior to the program start date, it is the applicant's/parent's responsibility to contact Fundamentally Dance via the contact channels on the Fundamentally Dance Website.

Please note that Fundamentally Dance does not provide participants with individual feedback outside of classes/sessions unless specified otherwise.

## **Eligibility**

Some of the courses Fundamentally Dance deploy are structured into age groups.

**Ages 10-14:** We recommend participants must have attained at least Grade 3 Ballet standard as recognised by the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD), Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing (ISTD), or International Dance Teachers Association (IDTA).

**Ages 15-17:** We recommend participants must have attained at least Grade 6/Intermediate Foundation Ballet standard as recognised by RAD, ISTD, or other examining body.

**Adults only courses:** These will run for participants age 18+.

Participants who have not reached these grade levels but believe they meet the standard may submit a short video to enquire about suitability to [ops@fundamentallydance.com](mailto:ops@fundamentallydance.com)  
Please use the email title:

Videos should be uploaded to YouTube or Google Drive set to private and shared via the provided email.

## Admittance

Participants must register through the official Fundamentally Dance (or its associated brand) website and complete all required fields in the registration form.

Full payment may be required to be made at the time of registration, via the specified online payment methods.

## Fees and Payments

A deposit may in some cases be due to secure a place on the course. Places are capped to ensure students receive adequate tuition. Full payment covers all tuition for the duration of the course applied for. Fees do not cover travel, accommodation, meals, or any other expenses, which are the responsibility of the participants, unless otherwise specified.

## Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellations must be made by emailing [ops@fundamentallydance.com](mailto:ops@fundamentallydance.com) with the title "Cancellation Request – [Participant's Name]/[Course Name]".

Refunds are available under the following conditions:

Cancellations 31 days prior to the activity are eligible for a 50% refund.

In some instances and for specific deployments or activities, it may specifically state that there is a no refunds policy.

No refunds will be given for cancellations made within 30 days of the start of the course. If the course is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as extreme weather or insufficient enrolment, full refunds will be issued.

## Conduct and Safety

Participants are expected to behave respectfully and professionally at all times during the course.

Fundamentally Dance reserves the right to dismiss any participant whose behaviour or conduct is deemed disruptive or dangerous, without refund. Participants are expected to meet the etiquette of a professional working environment and behaviour deemed inappropriate or disruptive in nature will not be tolerated and will lead to the participant being removed from the course without refund.

Fundamentally Dance will make every effort to ensure its policies, protocols and management of risks, particularly those around Health and Safety and Safeguarding are robust. All participants, parents and carers are asked to read all policies for Fundamentally Dance to ensure they are satisfied with the policies and protocols in place. Purchase of a course constitutes agreement to these policies.

## Health, Injuries and Allergies

Participants must disclose any pre-existing medical conditions or injuries that may affect their ability to participate fully in the course.

Fundamentally Dance is not responsible for personal injuries or health issues that may occur during the course. Participants are encouraged to have personal health insurance and to participate in activities only that are aligned with both their wellness and ability.

All participants are required to submit any allergy or medical information to the Fundamentally Dance team in advance, so that adequate provision can be made to fully support participants with medical needs.

## Intellectual Property

All training materials provided during the courses are the intellectual property of Fundamentally Dance and are not to be reproduced or distributed without prior written consent.

## Photography and Media

Fundamentally Dance may take photographs and videos during the courses primarily focusing on participants.

By participating in the courses, and agreeing to the GDPR/Privacy Law waiver, you grant Fundamentally Dance the right to use your images for promotional purposes, including but not
